The last RO or SRO remained a mystery for two years, but I had always thought that it should be ZERO. It was the only word I could find which had any significance to Thelema yet still approximated the sound required. But ZERO did not constitute a definite key. It was only with the writing of *The Book of Oz* that the answer was given to me. In the last verse of part one, the word MARVEL was given as a code. Transcribed as מַאֲרוֹל (MARVL) by the Hebrew Qabalah it is 277, the number of זרע (ZRO) – sperm.

If ZRO is rewritten as ZARO, the poem is made perfect. Not only do all three lines rhyme, but there are then 9 syllables in each. Nine is the key to the verse, and  $9 \times 3 = 27$ , חִידָא (CHIDA) – riddle.
